

10kV cable distance from cable tray



Overview

When transitioning cables from a tray to equipment or another raceway, the unsupported span cannot exceed 6 feet. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (A)) in that document provides requirements for cable support.
