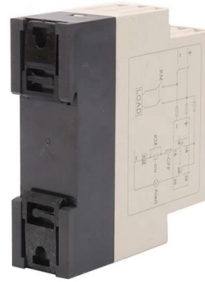


4-core optical fiber cable with color



Article Overview

The standard color sequence for the four fibers in a 4-core optical fiber cable is Blue, Orange, Green, and Brown.

Internal Fiber Colors

In a 4-core optical fiber cable, each fiber is individually color-coded to ensure proper identification during splicing, termination, and maintenance. According to the TIA-598-C standard, the first four fibers follow this sequence:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown This sequence is critical for technicians to correctly match fibers in duplex links or redundancy configurations, such as two duplex links or one duplex link with two backup fibers .

Outer Jacket and Buffer Tube Colors

The outer jacket of the cable may vary depending on the application:

- Indoor cables often use LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) jackets, which are typically white or off-white.
- Outdoor cables use PE (Polyethylene) jackets, often black for UV protection and waterproofing. Inside the cable, the buffer tube holding the fibers is usually blue or white, while the fibers themselves follow the Blue/Orange/Green/Brown sequence .
