Material Considerations

Using corrosion-resistant materials such as stainless steel, coated aluminum, galvanized steel, or fiberglass can significantly reduce the impact of rain. Galvanized steel, for example, forms a protective zinc oxide layer that slows corrosion, while aluminum naturally resists atmospheric agents due to its oxide film. Fiberglass and coated non-metallic options provide additional protection against moisture and UV exposure.

Weatherproofing and Installation Practices

Proper weatherproofing is essential for outdoor or exposed cable tray installations. Techniques include:

- Sealing building penetrations where trays enter walls or roofs using weatherstop systems or GRP sealants.
