

Cable tray large bend dimensions



Article Overview

Large cable tray bends are typically designed with a bend radius of 1.5 to 3 times the tray width, with width and side rail height matching the straight tray section to ensure proper cable fill and ventilation.

Bend Radius

The bend radius is the most critical dimension for large cable tray elbows. It ensures that cables can be routed without excessive stress or deformation. Standard practice is:

- Minimum bend radius: 1.5 times the tray width for medium-duty trays
- Large or heavy-duty trays: 2 to 3 times the tray width, especially for power or fiber optic cables to prevent kinking and maintain heat dissipation. For example, a 600mm wide ladder tray would typically have a large bend radius of 900mm to 1800mm.

Width and Side Rail Height

- Width: The inside width of the bend should match the straight tray section to maintain cable capacity and fill ratio. Standard widths range from 100mm to 600mm for most industrial applications, with wider trays exceeding 600mm for heavy cable loads.
- Side rail height (depth): Should also match the straight section, typically 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume and ventilation requirements. Ladder trays for heavy loads may require higher side rails for structural support.

Bend Angle and Type

- Common angles: 45° and 90° bends are standard.
