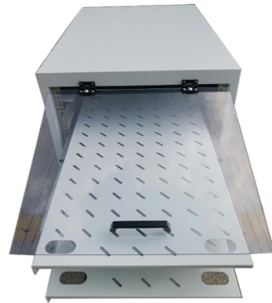


Campus Network Telecom Chassis Dimensions



Article Overview

Typical campus network chassis are designed to fit standard 19-inch racks, with heights ranging from 1U to 13U and depths from 15 to 30 inches depending on the model.

Standard Chassis Form Factors

Rack Width: Most campus network chassis, including Cisco Catalyst and similar enterprise switches, are designed for 19-inch racks, which is the industry standard for telecom and data center equipment. **Height (Rack Units, U):**

- Fixed access switches: Usually 1U to 2U high.
- Modular distribution or core chassis: Typically 6U to 13U, depending on the number of slots and modules supported.
- Stackable chassis: Often 2U to 4U, allowing multiple units to be stacked virtually.

Depth:

- Shallow access switches: 15–20 inches (380–500 mm)
- Deeper modular chassis: 24–30 inches (610–760 mm) to accommodate line cards, power supplies, and cooling airflow.

Weight Considerations:

- Smaller access switches: 10–25 lbs (4.5–11 kg)

- Large modular chassis: 80–150 lbs (36–68 kg) fully loaded with line cards and power supplies.
