

Can multiple laser diodes be connected in parallel



Article Overview

Laser diodes should generally not be connected in parallel directly due to uneven current distribution, but multiple current sources can be paralleled to drive a single diode safely.

Why Direct Parallel Connection is Problematic

Laser diodes are current-driven devices, meaning their output power is highly sensitive to the current supplied. When two or more diodes are connected in parallel, small differences in forward voltage between the diodes can cause one diode to draw more current than the others. This imbalance can lead to overdriving some diodes, resulting in uneven output power, overheating, or permanent damage to the diodes (RPMCLasers). Even minor variations in diode characteristics or temperature can exacerbate this effect, making direct parallel wiring unsafe for standard laser diodes.

Safe Alternatives

- **Series Connection:** Multiple diodes can be connected in series, where the same current flows through each diode. The power supply must provide a voltage high enough to cover the sum of the forward voltages of all diodes. This ensures equal current sharing and stable operation (RPMCLasers).
