- Design: Square push-pull connector with a 2.5 mm ferrule.

- Advantages: Low insertion loss, reliable performance, easy plug-and-play, and robust locking mechanism to prevent accidental disconnection . LC (Lucent Connector)

- Design: Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25 mm ferrule and push-pull latch.

- Applications: High-density data centers, LANs, SFP transceivers, and fiber patch panels.

- Advantages: Compact footprint, high performance, suitable for duplex or simplex configurations, ideal for space-constrained environments . ST (Straight Tip)

- Design: Bayonet-style twist-lock connector with a 2.5 mm ferrule.

- Applications: Legacy networks, industrial systems, and military-grade networks.

- Advantages: Robust mechanical connection, durable in harsh environments, though less common in modern networks . FC (Ferrule Connector)
