What is a Galvanized Cable Tray?

A galvanized cable tray is a steel cable support system coated with zinc, typically through hot-dip galvanization, which forms a metallurgical bond that protects the steel from rust and oxidation . These trays provide organized pathways for electrical power cables, data cables, control wiring, and fiber optics, replacing traditional conduit systems with easier access for installation, inspection, and maintenance .

Material and Corrosion Protection

The zinc coating acts as a sacrificial layer, corroding preferentially to protect the underlying steel. Over time, exposure to air and moisture forms a zinc carbonate patina, which is highly adherent and insoluble, further enhancing corrosion resistance . The thickness of the zinc layer directly affects the tray's durability, with hot-dip galvanization providing thicker, longer-lasting protection compared to electro-galvanization .

Design Considerations

When selecting or designing galvanized cable trays, consider:

- **Load Capacity and Span:** Ensure the tray can support the weight of cables over the intended span without excessive deflection .
