

Connect the distribution boxes in series



Article Overview

Distribution boxes can be connected in series by feeding the outgoing circuits of one box into the incoming terminals of the next, ensuring proper protection and load management.

Key Principles

- **Main Power Off:** Always turn off the main power supply before starting any connections to prevent electrical shock or damage .
- **Primary Distribution Box Setup:** Connect the incoming live (phase) and neutral wires to the main terminals of the first distribution box. Install the main MCB or switch and connect all circuit breakers for the loads served by this box .
- **Feeding the Next Box:** To connect a second distribution box in series, run a feeder cable from the outgoing terminals (phase and neutral) of the first box to the incoming terminals of the second box. This effectively makes the second box a downstream distribution point .
- **Circuit Protection:** Each distribution box should have its own protective devices (MCBs, RCCBs) to prevent overloads and short circuits. Ensure the feeder cable is rated for the total load of the downstream box .
- **Grounding and Safety:** Properly ground each distribution box according to local electrical codes. Maintain clear labeling of all circuits to simplify maintenance and troubleshooting .
- **Testing:** After wiring, use a multimeter to verify continuity, correct voltage, and absence of short circuits before energizing the system .
