A construction site distribution box safely distributes temporary power to multiple circuits, requiring proper grounding, protection devices, and compliance with NEC/OSHA standards.

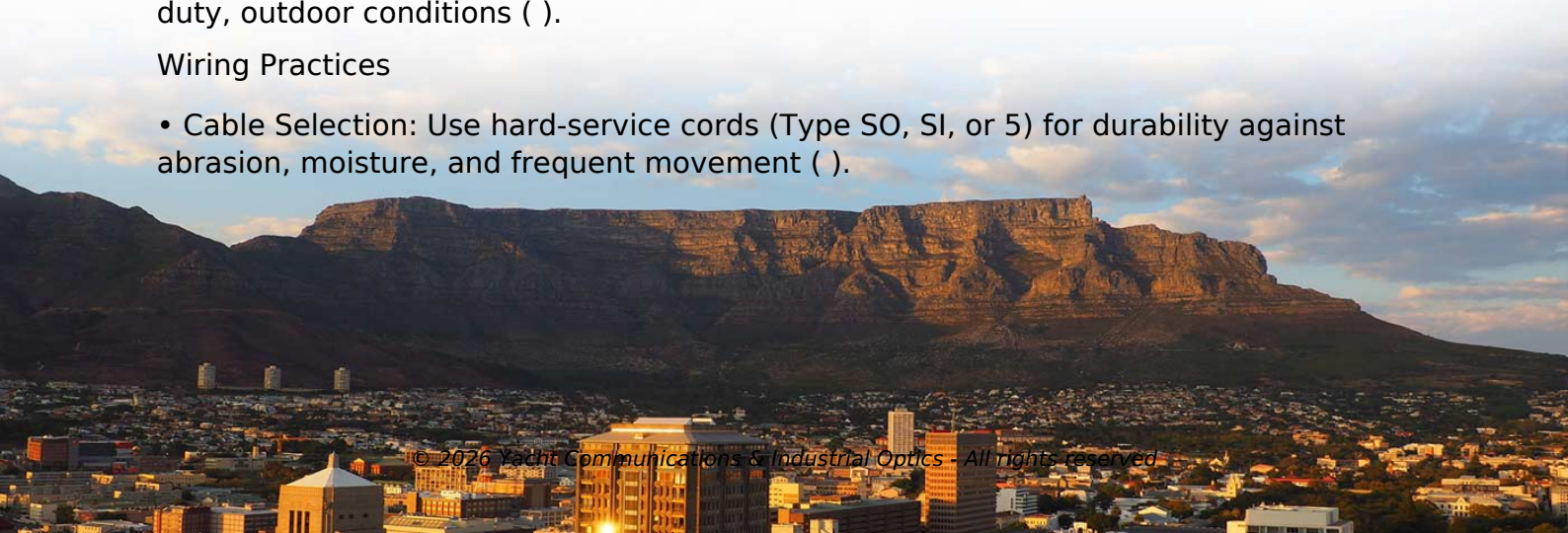
Key Components

A typical construction site distribution box includes:

- Enclosure: Protects internal components from dust, moisture, and impact. Choose a box with appropriate IP or NEMA rating for outdoor or industrial use ().
- Main Circuit Breaker (MCCB): Controls overall power input and provides overload protection.
- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect individual circuits for lighting, machinery, or welding equipment ().
- Grounding Terminals: Ensure proper earthing to prevent electrocution.
- Industrial Plug Sockets/Connectors: Use CEE or IP67-rated connectors for heavy-duty, outdoor conditions ().

Wiring Practices

- Cable Selection: Use hard-service cords (Type SO, SI, or 5) for durability against abrasion, moisture, and frequent movement ().
