

Dimensions of a three-level electrical distribution box on a construction site



Article Overview

A three-level construction site distribution box typically consists of a main distribution cabinet, a secondary distribution box, and a final switch/junction box, with dimensions varying based on power requirements but generally ranging from 600–1200 mm in height, 400–800 mm in width, and 250–500 mm in depth.

Structure and Levels

Three-level distribution boxes are designed to provide staged protection and organized power distribution on construction sites . The levels include:

- **First Level (Main Distribution Box):** Handles incoming power, usually with bottom-in and bottom-out lines. It contains the main busbar, measuring systems, and primary protection devices. The cabinet is rainproof and suitable for outdoor installation .
- **Second Level (Secondary Distribution Box):** Positioned under the main box, it features inner and outer doors, often spray-painted for durability. It distributes power to multiple circuits and may include additional protection devices .
- **Third Level (Final Switch/Junction Box):** The lowest level, installed under the secondary box, provides final connections to electrical appliances. It can be fixed or movable and includes leakage protection switches for safety .

Typical Dimensions

While exact sizes depend on manufacturer and site requirements, common dimensions for three-level boxes are approximately:

- **Height:** 600–1200 mm
