

Distribution box configuration for 3 bedrooms and 2 living rooms



Article Overview

A typical distribution box for a 3-bedroom, 2-living room home should include separate circuits for each room's sockets, dedicated circuits for high-power appliances, and independent lighting circuits, with a main switch and space for future expansion.

Recommended Circuit Allocation

- Main Switch
- Controls the entire electrical system and allows for emergency shutdown or maintenance .
- Room Socket Circuits
- Each bedroom and living room should have its own circuit to isolate electrical issues.
- Bedrooms: 1 circuit per room (3 circuits total).
- Living rooms: 1 circuit per room (2 circuits total).
- Kitchen and utility areas: 2-4 circuits for sockets, depending on appliance load .
- High-Power Appliance Circuits
- Dedicated circuits for appliances such as:
 - Electric stove or oven
 - Air conditioner(s)
 - Water heater
