Placing a distribution box directly on the ground is generally not recommended; it should be elevated slightly to prevent moisture damage and ensure proper grounding and accessibility.

Safety and Environmental Considerations

Distribution boxes are designed to protect electrical components from water, dust, and physical damage. Installing a box directly on the ground exposes it to moisture, dirt, and potential flooding, which can compromise safety and functionality. For outdoor or ground-level installations, it is recommended to raise the box 2 to 4 inches (5–10 cm) above the ground to prevent water ingress and corrosion while maintaining compliance with standards like BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52 . Additionally, the box should be placed in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation .

Grounding Requirements

Proper grounding is critical for safety. Each distribution box must be connected to a central grounding point using appropriately sized ground wires. For example, in the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is standard, while other markets may require a 6 mm² wire . The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure safe operation . Grounding wires should be securely attached to the mounting plate and connected to the factory or building ground.
