Overview

Cable trays are structures designed to support and organize electrical cables. While many trays can be fitted with covers, cover plates are not a mandatory feature for all cable trays. The decision to use a cover depends on factors such as protection from dust, debris, moisture, electromagnetic interference, or mechanical impact, as well as aesthetic or safety considerations .

- Dome-shaped (Hat) Covers: Protect overfilled trays and deflect falling debris, often used outdoors .
- Flat Covers: Ideal for corridors or data centers where space is limited and aesthetics matter .
- Peaked and Corrugated Covers: Provide structural reinforcement and are suitable for outdoor or seismic-prone areas .
- Finned Covers: Enhance ventilation, commonly used in industrial control panels .
- Hinged or Flanged Covers: Allow easy access for maintenance while providing sealing in clean environments . Covers can be made from metal, composite, or plastic materials, with metal and composite being the most common due to durability and environmental resistance .
