Power Requirements

Telecommunications towers rely on electricity to power the Base Transceiver Station (BTS), which handles all communication between the mobile network and end-user devices, including calls, data, and other services . The electricity also powers cooling systems, lighting, and safety equipment such as aviation lights and lightning protection . A typical 4G tower consumes about 3-6 MWh per month, while 5G-enabled towers can reach 6-12 MWh per month, reflecting the higher energy demand of modern networks .

Power Supply Systems

Most towers are connected to the local electrical grid, but in areas with unreliable or no grid access, towers use diesel generators, battery backups, or hybrid renewable systems . Batteries and generators ensure continuous operation during power outages, which is critical for maintaining network reliability . Modern towers increasingly adopt hybrid solar-plus-storage systems, sometimes combined with wind turbines, to provide a more sustainable and cost-effective power supply .
