It contains a GPU processor, VRAM, power delivery circuits, and display outputs such as HDMI or DisplayPort, which allow it to function independently in a standard PC or workstation environment. For most users, including gamers, content creators, and general computing tasks, no optical module is needed.

Role of Optical Modules

Optical modules are transceivers used for high-speed data transfer over fiber optic networks. They are commonly employed in data centers, AI clusters, or supercomputing environments where multiple GPUs need to communicate at extremely high bandwidths, such as in NVIDIA DGX SuperPOD setups. The number of optical modules depends on the network card model, switch architecture, and cluster size, not on the GPU itself. For example, A100 or H100 GPUs in large-scale clusters may use ConnectX network cards with optical modules to achieve 200-400 Gb/s or higher interconnect speeds.
