Wiring in High-Voltage Distribution

- **Ground wires or connections:** Grounding is critical for safety, protecting equipment and personnel from faults or lightning strikes. While the ground wire normally carries no current, it provides a path for excess or fault current .

Single-Phase vs Three-Phase Systems

- **Single-phase distribution:** Typically has one live wire and one neutral wire, with a ground connection for safety. This is common for residential areas with lighter loads .
