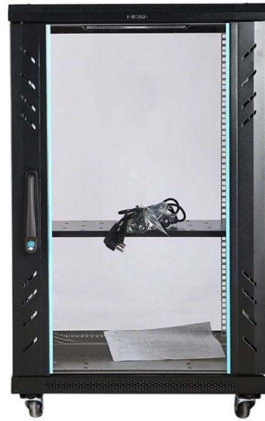


Does the distribution box need to be equipped with an electricity meter

No, it is not necessary or recommended to install an electricity meter inside a distribution box; meters should be housed in a dedicated meter enclosure.

Key Differences Between Meter Boxes and Distribution Boxes

A meter box is specifically designed to house the electricity meter and related service connections. It serves as the official interface between the utility supply and the consumer's internal electrical system, allowing accurate measurement of energy consumption and safe access for inspection and maintenance . In contrast, a distribution box distributes incoming power to multiple circuits within a building and contains protective devices like MCBs, RCCBs, or RCBOs . The functions of these two enclosures do not overlap, and combining them can violate safety and regulatory standards.

Regulatory and Safety Considerations

Industry guidance, such as that from the Energy Networks Association (ENA) and NICEIC, specifies that meter enclosures should only contain intake and metering equipment. This includes the main isolating device, the electricity meter, and possibly a single- or double-pole isolation device between the meter and the consumer unit . Installing additional equipment, such as circuit breakers or other distribution components, inside the meter enclosure is not allowed and can prevent future upgrades or maintenance, potentially incurring costs and safety risks .
