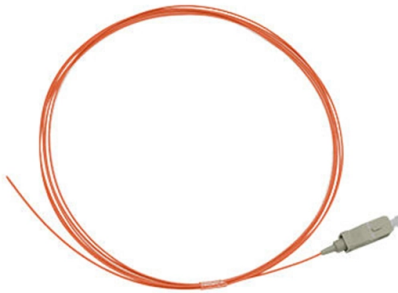


Effective distance of butterfly-shaped optical cable

Butterfly-shaped optical cables typically come in lengths ranging from 100 meters to several kilometers, depending on deployment type and installation requirements.

Standard Lengths and Deployment

Butterfly-shaped optical cables, commonly used in FTTH networks, are available in both indoor and self-supporting outdoor variants. Indoor cables are often supplied in spools of 100 meters or 500 meters, suitable for routing through walls, conduits, or ceilings, while self-supporting outdoor cables can be delivered in longer reels, sometimes up to 2 km or more, to span from distribution points to subscriber buildings . The exact length depends on the installation scenario, fiber core count, and whether the cable is pre-connectorized.

Factors Affecting Cable Length

- **Fiber Type:** Single-mode fibers, which are standard in butterfly cables, allow longer transmission distances (10–40 km) without signal degradation, influencing the practical length of a single cable run .
- **Mechanical Design:** The butterfly configuration, with a central fiber unit and two parallel strength members, provides flexibility and protection, allowing longer continuous runs without splicing .
- **Installation Environment:** Indoor cables are shorter due to routing constraints, while outdoor self-supporting cables are longer to minimize the number of splices and support aerial spans .
