Practice good wiring: secure grounding, neat cable management, proper insulation, and correct wire gauge and breaker. Mark and drill holes → fix box with expansion bolts. Keep box level and stable; use waterproof type if outdoors. Wiring Connections Strip wires → connect to terminals (phase, neutral, ground) → arrange neatly. Final. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. Manufacturer-provided holes, especially for surface-mounted boxes, may not suit actual needs.
