Active Optical Cables (AOCs) offer energy-efficient, high-speed interconnects ideal for high-density IDC deployments, combining low power consumption with long reach and minimal EMI.

Understanding AOC Cables

AOCs are high-speed cables that integrate optical fiber with transceivers at both ends, converting electrical signals to optical and back, enabling data transmission over longer distances than copper cables without significant signal loss . Unlike DACs, AOCs are lightweight, flexible, and immune to electromagnetic interference (EMI), which reduces the need for additional cooling and improves airflow in dense racks . The embedded electronics do consume power, but overall, AOCs are more energy-efficient than equivalent copper solutions, especially for high-speed links over tens to hundreds of meters .

Key Energy-Saving Selection Criteria

- Data Rate and Cable Type
- Choose AOCs that match your network speed requirements (25G, 100G, 200G, 400G, or 800G). Higher-speed AOCs are optimized for low power per bit transmitted, reducing energy consumption per unit of data .
