

Ethernet to Fiber Optic FC Interface



Article Overview

An Ethernet to Fibre Channel interface is typically implemented via SFP/SFP+ modules, media converters, or switch ports configured as FC interfaces connecting Ethernet networks to SANs.

Physical Location

The Ethernet-to-FC interface can exist in several forms:

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Switch Ports: On devices like Juniper QFX or Cisco Nexus switches, specific Ethernet ports (e.g., xe-0/0/0 through xe-0/0/5) can be configured as native FC interfaces (fc-0/0/0 through fc-0/0/5) to connect directly to Fibre Channel SAN switches . These ports are physically located on the switch chassis and may require optional expansion modules for additional FC ports .

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Media Converters: Industrial Ethernet networks often use media converters to bridge Ethernet and fiber optics. These devices convert electrical Ethernet signals into optical signals compatible with FC or fiber networks, supporting distances up to 80 km and data rates up to 1 Gbps . Media converters are typically mounted on DIN rails or inside control cabinets.
