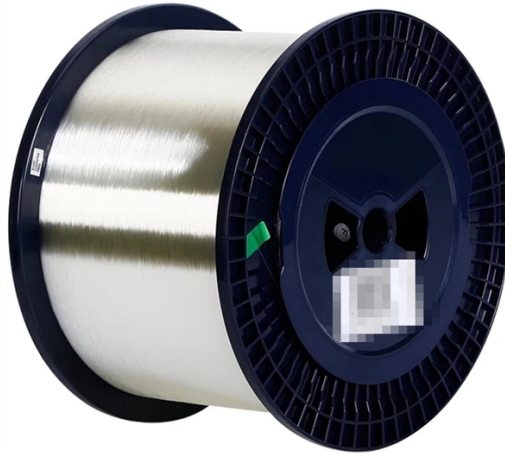


Feedback wiring of fire fan distribution box



Article Overview

Feedback wiring in a fire fan distribution box ensures fan status is monitored and integrated with fire alarm or smoke control systems using relays and auxiliary contacts.

Overview

A fire fan distribution box is designed to control fans that provide smoke pressurization or ventilation during a fire. Feedback wiring allows the system to report the operational status of fans (running, stopped, or fault) to a fire alarm control panel or smoke control panel, ensuring compliance with building codes and safety standards ().

Wiring Principles

- Relay Integration
 - Fire fans are typically controlled via a fire system relay or a higher-load relay capable of handling the fan motor current ().
 - The relay coil is energized or de-energized by the fire alarm system. When the fire alarm activates, the relay switches the fan on or off depending on the design.
 - Feedback is provided through auxiliary contacts on the relay, which indicate the fan's operational state to the control panel.
- Load Considerations
 - Standard fire system relays are rated for low currents (commonly 500 mA), sufficient for signaling but not for directly switching large fan motors ().
