

# Fiber Optic Cable Installation Location Diagram



## Article Overview

A typical fiber optic cable installation diagram shows the route from the service provider's network to the end-user, including conduits, splices, termination points, and the optical network terminal (ONT).

### Key Components in a Fiber Optic Installation Diagram

- **Service Provider Network (Central Office or Headend)** The starting point of the fiber network, where the main fiber lines originate and connect to the broader internet backbone .
- **Distribution Fiber Cables** These cables run from the central office to neighborhoods or buildings. They can be aerial (on poles) or underground (in conduits or micro-trenches) depending on environmental and regulatory factors .
- **Splice Points / Fiber Distribution Hubs** Intermediate points where fiber cables are spliced or split to serve multiple locations. Splicing can be fusion splicing for permanent connections or mechanical splicing for temporary setups .
- **Drop Fiber Cable** The segment connecting the distribution hub to the customer premises. This is often a smaller, flexible cable designed for indoor or outdoor routing .
- **Termination Enclosure / Wall Box** Installed at the customer premises, this enclosure protects the fiber and provides a point for connecting the optical network terminal (ONT) .
