Preparing the Junction Box

Before installation, gather all necessary tools and materials, including screws, dowels, a spirit level, cable grommets, and protective equipment. Mark drill holes carefully to mount the box straight, drill, insert dowels, and secure the box with screws . Ensure the box is made of durable materials like aluminum alloy for long-term protection .

Handling and Routing Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables are fragile and must be handled with care. Remove the outer sheath carefully to avoid damaging the fibers, and use pre-terminated branch fiber jumpers or pigtails when possible . Introduce the cable into the box through the designated inlet, using grommets to secure it. Maintain proper bending radius using clips or spools inside the box to prevent signal loss . Ensure the cable length allows the front panel to be fully extended without tension.
