

Fiber optic cable hanging point bolts



Article Overview

Fiber optic cable hanging points are typically secured using specialized bolts that attach brackets or hooks to poles, ensuring stable and safe cable installation.

Overview of Hanging Hardware

Fiber optic cables, especially ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) and FTTH drop cables, are supported on poles using brackets, J-hooks, clamps, and suspension grips. These components are designed to hold the cable securely, prevent sagging, and maintain proper clearance from other infrastructure such as power lines or cross-arms (JERA LINE) . The hardware is usually made from durable materials like steel or aluminum alloy to withstand environmental stress, including wind, ice, and UV exposure .

Types of Bolts and Installation

- **Poleline Bolts:** These bolts are used to attach brackets or hooks directly to wooden, metal, or concrete poles. For drilled poles, bolts typically range from 14–16 mm in diameter, with a length at least equal to the pole diameter plus 20 mm to ensure secure anchoring .
- **Pigtail or J-Hook Bolts:** These are used to hang and organize cables neatly along the pole. The hooks have a curved shape allowing cables to wrap around them, minimizing tangling and maintaining proper spacing .
- **Track Bolts and Nuts:** In some aerial installations, 1/2"-13 track bolts are used to attach hardware to poles or cross-arms, providing a broad bearing surface and strong compression grip for the cable support .
