A hook-type fiber optic patch cord is a fiber jumper designed with a hook-style connector or strain relief feature for easy routing and secure connections in high-density or tight-space environments.

Overview

A fiber optic patch cord is a short optical cable with connectors on both ends, used to connect devices such as switches, transceivers, patch panels, and servers within a network . The hook-type variant incorporates a hook or latch mechanism on the connector or cable jacket, allowing it to be easily secured, routed, or removed without damaging the fiber. This design is particularly useful in high-density racks, data centers, or FTTH (Fiber to the Home) installations where space is limited .

Structure

A typical hook-type fiber patch cord includes:

- Optical Fiber Core: Single-mode (OS1/OS2) for long-distance, low-attenuation transmission, or multimode (OM1-OM5) for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications .
- Strength Member: Kevlar (aramid yarn) under the jacket to protect against tension and bending .
- Outer Jacket: PVC, LSZH, or plenum-rated materials depending on fire safety and installation environment .
