

Fire protection requirements for distribution box enclosures



Article Overview

Distribution box enclosures must be constructed from non-combustible or fire-resistant materials and meet specific fire resistance ratings such as F30/F90, I30/I90, or E30/E90 according to international and national standards.

Fire Resistance and Material Requirements

Distribution enclosures should be made of non-combustible or fireproof materials to prevent fire propagation and maintain functionality during a fire. Fire resistance ratings are commonly defined as:

- F30/F90: Fire resistance duration of 30 or 90 minutes for the enclosure structure.
- I30/I90: Interior fire protection, ensuring internal components are shielded for 30 or 90 minutes.
- E30/E90: Exterior fire protection, preventing fire spread outside the enclosure for 30 or 90 minutes. Testing for these classifications is typically conducted according to DIN 4102 Part 2, 11, and 12 standards for European enclosures .

Regulatory Standards

- IEC 60364: International standard for electrical installations, including protection against thermal effects and fire hazards .
- BS 7671 (UK Wiring Regulations): Requires switchgear or controlgear in escape routes to be enclosed in non-combustible or not readily combustible materials .
