A new cover not only protects the components from dust and damage but also ensures compliance with safety standards. Start at the main service panel, typically located in a basement, garage, or utility area. Locate the specific circuit breaker corresponding to the damaged box and switch it to the “Off”. An electrical box cover serves a dual function in any residential or commercial setting, whether for a junction box, switch, or outlet. Use a voltage tester to ensure the wires are not live before touching anything.
