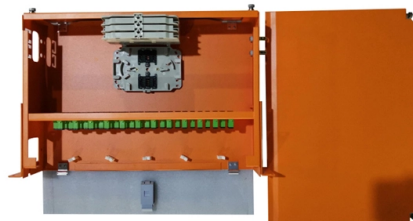

Overview

A frame switch optical port is a physical interface on a network switch designed to connect fiber optic cables. These ports are commonly found on industrial, enterprise, and aggregation switches and support various fiber types, including single-mode, multi-mode, and specialized fibers like Plastic Optical Fiber (POF) or Hard Clad Silica (HCS) fibers . They allow switches to transmit data over long distances with minimal signal loss, which is essential for linking remote sites or high-bandwidth applications .

Types of Optical Ports

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Hot-swappable modules that support different fiber types and distances, often used in Gigabit Ethernet switches .
- SFP+ and SFP28: Higher-speed variants supporting 10 Gbps and 25 Gbps connections, suitable for aggregation switches .
- Custom Optical Switch Ports: Some optical switch boxes, like the MLO4034-LR8, integrate multiple optical ports with WDM, variable optical attenuators, and power monitoring for testing and automation purposes .

- Hot-swappable modules: Users can insert or replace SFP modules without powering down the switch .
