GPON is an alternative to Ethernet switching in campus networking. GPON replaces the traditional three-tier Ethernet design with a two-tier optic network which eliminates access and distribution Ethernet switches with passive optical devices. Cisco introduces GPON with the Catalyst GPON platform. In today's rapidly evolving optical networking landscape, GPON (Gigabit Passive Optical Network) technology stands as the mainstream solution for delivering fast, stable, and high-capacity data access. Behind this technology lie two key pieces of equipment — the OLT on the operator side and the ONU/ONT on the subscriber side — whose mastery is essential for any fiber technician, network. A gigabit passive optical network (G-PON) comprises optical line terminals (OLTs) and optical network units (ONUs), and Murata's lineup of products for use in OLTs is introduced here. Each PON port theoretically can serve up to 128 ONTs but in practice this number should be calculated based on the characteristics of the.
