

Heavy-duty cable tray load-bearing standards



Overview

The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) VE 1 standard is the primary guideline for specifying cable tray systems, particularly defining load capacity and span capabilities. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. Safe working loads are represented graphically as shown and are based on the cable tray being continuous over four spans or more. Deflection has been limited to $\text{SPAN}/200$ generally, based on the end span condition as the worst case.
