

High attenuation in optical fiber splices



Overview

Fusion splices, where two fiber ends are permanently melted together, perform much better. This influence may be caused by the diffusion of H_2 atoms directly into the silicon (Si) structure of the optical fibers or by the formation of OH ions at locations where the fiber surface is damaged. An optical link consists of cable sections and splices of optical cables within the cable. In the high-speed world of fiber optic communication, data travels at the speed of light. Optical Signal Attenuation is the single greatest factor limiting the distance and performance of your network. It's measured in decibels per kilometer (dB/km), and it determines how far a signal can travel before it becomes too weak to read. This loss can occur due to various factors, which can be broadly categorized into three main types: absorption and scattering losses, bending and micro-bending losses, and connector and splice.
