- **Unmanaged Switches:** Plug-and-play devices with minimal configuration, suitable for smaller home networks where simplicity and cost are priorities .

Consider Port Quantity and Type

Select a switch with enough ports to accommodate all your devices. Common fiber interfaces include LC, SC, and ST, and you should confirm whether your network uses single-mode or multi-mode fiber. Single-mode supports longer distances and higher bandwidth, while multi-mode is more cost-effective for shorter home runs .
