

How is the distribution box configured



Article Overview

A distribution box is configured to safely receive incoming power and distribute it to multiple circuits through organized protective and switching devices.

Core Components and Layout

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or breaker box, typically contains the following key components:

- Main Switch or Main Breaker: Controls the entire electrical supply to the box, allowing complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies .
- Busbars: Conductive bars, usually made of copper or aluminum, that distribute power to individual circuits .
- Circuit Breakers or Fuses: Protect individual circuits from overloads or short circuits by automatically interrupting power flow .
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs) / RCBOs: Provide personal protection by detecting leakage currents and disconnecting the circuit to prevent electric shock .
- Neutral and Earth Bars: Central points for connecting neutral and grounding wires, ensuring proper earthing and safety .
- Surge Protective Devices (SPDs): Protect sensitive equipment from voltage spikes .
- DIN Rails: Standardized mounting rails for securing breakers, RCDs, and other modular devices .
