

How many cascaded layers can an access switch be



Article Overview

For access layer switches, it is generally recommended to cascade no more than 2-3 switches to maintain performance and reliability.

Practical Limitations

Cascading switches, also known as daisy-chaining, involves connecting one switch to another to expand network capacity. While technically multiple switches can be connected in series, several factors limit the number of cascaded layers:

- **Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) Constraints:** STP or Rapid STP is used to prevent loops in Layer 2 networks. Depending on the protocol and configuration, the maximum number of switches in a loop-free network is typically 7-12, but practical deployment at the access layer is much lower to avoid complexity and convergence delays (Robots.net) .
- **Bandwidth Bottlenecks:** Each additional switch in the cascade aggregates traffic toward the uplink, creating potential congestion. This can severely impact performance if too many switches are chained (Cisco Community) .
- **Signal Degradation and Latency:** Each switch introduces slight latency and potential signal loss, which can accumulate in long cascades, affecting network responsiveness (Robots.net) .
