

How many white tubes are needed for a 24-core optical fiber cable



Overview

The color sequence for 24-fiber optic cables is: composed of 4 tubes, each containing 6 fibers with the colors blue, orange, green, brown, gray, and white. Fibers will be bundled in groups of 12 fibers and inserted into the clear furcation tubing. Tube 1 will have fibers 1-12, tube 2 will have fibers 13-24, and.
