

How many wires are needed for the distribution box

A standard distribution box typically requires five incoming wires—three-phase lines, one neutral, and one ground—with additional outgoing wires depending on the number and type of circuits.

Incoming Wires

For most distribution boxes, the incoming power line uses a five-wire system: three-phase lines (A, B, C), one neutral line, and one ground line. The phase lines are usually color-coded yellow, green, and red, the neutral is light blue, and the ground is yellow with green stripes. This setup accommodates both single-phase (220V) and three-phase (380V) loads.

- Single-phase 220V load: one phase line + one neutral + one ground.
- Three-phase 380V load: all three phase lines + neutral + ground.
- Special two-phase 380V equipment: any two-phase lines + ground, with neutral added if local control is required.

Outgoing Wires

The number of outgoing wires depends on the number of circuits connected to the distribution box. Each circuit typically requires:

- One live (phase) wire
- One neutral wire
