Fill ratio — IEC 61537 and NEC Article 392 both cap power cables at 40–50 % of the tray cross-section. Standard Lengths: Rung Spacing Options: Material Thickness: For ladder trays, side rail height and material thickness matter more than rung spacing when it comes to load capacity. Wider trays are typically preferred over deeper ones for power and solar DC runs to reduce cable stacking and heat. Cable trays come in standardized dimensions based on international regulations like NEC (National Electrical Code) and IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission).
