

How to access the core switch URL



Article Overview

You can access a core switch's web interface by connecting to its management IP via a web browser, ensuring your PC is on the same subnet or has proper routing configured.

Steps to Access the Switch Web UI

1. Determine the Switch IP Address

- For a new or reset switch, use the default IP (e.g., Cisco: 192.168.1.254, TP-Link: 192.168.0.1) .
 - If the switch has a static IP configured, use that address. You may need to check the VLAN interface IP if the switch uses VLAN-based management .
- #### 2. Configure Your PC Network Settings
- Ensure your computer's Ethernet adapter is on the same subnet as the switch. For example, if the switch IP is 192.168.1.254, set your PC to an IP like 192.168.1.10 with subnet mask 255.255.255.0 .
 - On Windows, go to Network Connections → Ethernet → Properties → IPv4 → Use the following IP address. On macOS, configure the IP in System Preferences → Network → Advanced → TCP/IP.
- #### 3. Connect to the Switch
- Use an Ethernet cable to connect your PC to a switch port. For initial setup, connect directly to a numbered port on the switch .
 - Launch a web browser and enter the switch IP in the address bar (e.g., or <https://192.168.1.254>) .
- #### 4. Login Credentials
- Default username and password are usually admin/admin .
