

How to adjust the height of cable trays

Cable tray height can be adjusted using vertical hangers, threaded rods, and specialized adjustable couplers to ensure proper alignment and support between tray sections.

Vertical Hanger and Threaded Rod Method

One common technique involves using threaded rods with hex nuts and washers to adjust the height of cable trays. The process typically includes:

- Installing vertical hangers or threaded rods at the desired tray locations.
- Placing square or round washers and cross members on the rods.
- Threading hex nuts above and below the cross member to allow fine vertical adjustment.
- Lifting the tray section so the threaded rod passes through the clamp or tray clip, then tightening the nuts to secure the tray at the desired height.
- This method allows precise vertical positioning and minor horizontal adjustments depending on rod length, ensuring trays are level and properly supported.

Adjustable Couplers

For connecting adjacent tray sections at different heights, vertical adjustable couplers are widely used:

- These couplers feature easi-bend slots that allow on-site adjustment for vertical and horizontal offsets.
