

How to arrange cable tray routes

Routing a cable tray requires careful planning, proper support, and adherence to spacing and safety standards to ensure efficient and safe cable management.

Step 1: Plan the Route

Before installation, mark the cable tray route based on approved shop drawings and site layout. Consider the tray's purpose, cable types, load capacity, and clearance from other systems like HVAC ducts, fire pipes, and drainage systems . Use a laser level to trace straight lines on walls or ceilings to ensure alignment . Planning helps avoid clashes and reduces the need for adjustments during installation.

Step 2: Select the Right Tray Type

Choose a tray type that suits your application:

- Ladder trays: Allow airflow and easy cable entry, ideal for heavy power cables .
- Perforated trays: Support lighter loads and provide ventilation.
- Solid-bottom trays: Protect sensitive instrumentation or control cables from dust and interference . Consider material and finish based on environmental conditions, such as aluminum for corrosion resistance .
