

How to bind a fiber optic router device

To connect a fiber optic router, you must first link the fiber cable to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) and then bridge the ONT to your router using an Ethernet cable.

Required Components

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals your router can use, usually provided by your ISP .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable: Cat6a or higher recommended for optimal speeds .
- Fiber-ready router: Ensure it supports gigabit speeds or higher and has a WAN port .

Step-by-Step Connection

- Locate the fiber wall outlet: This is where your ISP's fiber line enters your home or office .
- Connect the fiber cable to the ONT: Remove protective caps, align the connector key, and insert until it clicks securely. Handle the fiber connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
- Power on the ONT: Plug in the power adapter and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network .
- Bridge the ONT to the router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. The WAN port is usually labeled and may be color-coded .
