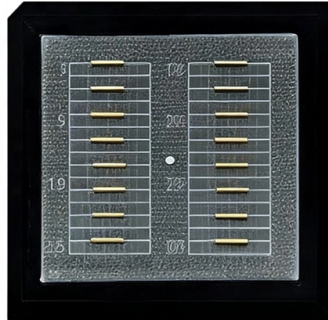


How to configure a 13-position distribution box

A 13-position distribution box divides a single power source into 13 separate circuits, with organized terminals, protective devices, and flexible cable entry points for safe and efficient electrical distribution.

Overview

A 13-position distribution box is designed to safely distribute power from one input to 13 independent circuits, making it suitable for residential, commercial, and industrial applications. It typically includes circuit breakers, busbars, neutral and earth bars, and terminal blocks, all arranged to ensure organized wiring and easy maintenance.

Internal Layout and Components

- **Single-row or modular design:** Most 13-way boxes use a single-row layout for compactness, though some allow modular expansion.
- **Circuit breakers:** Each of the 13 circuits is protected by an MCB, RCBO, or fuse, often with adjustable trip settings to match load requirements.
- **Busbars:** Separate busbars for phase, neutral, and earth ensure proper current distribution and grounding.
- **Terminal identification:** Clear labeling and pre-marked terminals reduce wiring errors and simplify inspections.
- **DIN rails:** Many boxes include DIN rails for mounting additional protective devices or surge protectors.
