

How to connect a multimode fiber optic interface

To connect a multimode fiber optic cable interface, use a duplex LC-terminated multimode fiber cable with a compatible SFP transceiver, ensuring correct TX/RX polarity and clean connectors.

Required Components

- **SFP Transceiver Module:** Select a multimode SFP module compatible with your network switch or router, matching the required bandwidth (1G SFP, 10G SFP+, etc.) .
- **Duplex Multimode Fiber Cable:** Use OM3 or OM4 multimode fiber with two strands for transmit (TX) and receive (RX) signals .
- **LC Connectors:** Most SFP modules use LC duplex connectors, either pre-terminated or field-installed .

Step-by-Step Connection Procedure

- **Insert the SFP Module:** Fully insert the SFP transceiver into the compatible port on your switch, router, or media converter until it clicks .
- **Prepare the Fiber Cable:** Remove protective dust caps from both the SFP port and the fiber cable connectors. Clean the fiber end faces with a lint-free wipe or fiber cleaning tool to reduce insertion loss .
- **Connect the Fiber:** Align the LC connectors with the SFP module ports and gently push until they lock. Ensure TX on one device connects to RX on the other device to maintain proper polarity .
