

How to connect a pigtail cable and a network cable

Connecting a pigtail to a network cable involves either splicing a fiber optic pigtail to a fiber cable or crimping/soldering an electrical pigtail to a copper network cable.

Fiber Optic Pigtail Connection

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a pre-installed connector on one end and an exposed fiber on the other. To connect it to a network cable:

- Prepare the fiber cable: Strip the outer jacket and clean the exposed fiber using isopropyl alcohol to remove dust and debris .
- Splice the pigtail: Use a fusion splicer to join the bare end of the pigtail to the fiber in the network cable. This ensures minimal signal loss and high-quality connectivity .
- Protect the splice: Place the fused fiber in a splice tray or protective sleeve to prevent damage.
- Connect the pigtail: Plug the factory-terminated connector into the network device, patch panel, or adapter .
- Test the connection: Use an optical power meter or OTDR to verify signal integrity and low attenuation. Common fiber pigtail connectors include LC, SC, ST, and FC types, each suitable for different network applications .

Electrical Pigtail Connection

An electrical pigtail is a short wire with a connector on one end and bare wires on the other. To connect it to a network cable (typically copper Ethernet):
