

How to connect a pigtail to an optical fiber distribution cabinet

Connecting a fiber optic pigtail to a distribution cabinet involves preparing the fiber, fusion splicing the pigtail to the incoming cable, and terminating the connector in the cabinet for a clean, low-loss connection.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber and Pigtail

- Select a high-quality pigtail with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other .
- Strip the outer jacket of the incoming fiber cable carefully to expose the bare fiber.
- Clean the fiber using alcohol wipes and lint-free cloths to remove dust and debris .
- Cut the fiber precisely using a fiber cleaver to ensure a smooth end for splicing .

Step 2: Fusion Splicing

- Align the bare end of the pigtail with the prepared incoming fiber in a fusion splicer .
- Perform the fusion splice according to the splicer's instructions, ensuring minimal signal loss.
- Protect the splice with a heat-shrink sleeve or splice protector to maintain durability and prevent damage .
