

How to connect a router to an external fiber optic cable



Article Overview

To connect an external router to a fiber optic cable, you must use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet, then link it to your router's WAN port.

Required Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts the fiber optic signal into an electrical signal your router can use .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Router compatible with fiber input: Look for a WAN port or SFP/PON port .
- Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher recommended): Connects the ONT to the router .

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT
- Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall to the ONT's optical port, handling the connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network .
