

How to connect the small busbar of a DC power supply



Article Overview

To connect a small busbar in a DC power supply, ensure all power is disconnected, select the correct wire gauge, properly strip and crimp terminal lugs, and securely bolt them to the busbar with the correct torque.

Safety First

Before starting, disconnect all power sources, including batteries and any DC inputs, to achieve a zero-energy state. Always wear insulated gloves and safety glasses, and verify circuits are dead using a multimeter . This prevents accidental short circuits or electric shock.

Selecting the Busbar and Wires

Choose a busbar rated for the maximum expected current plus a safety margin (typically 125% of the load). Small busbars often serve auxiliary circuits or low-current branches, but the same principles apply: the busbar material should be highly conductive, like tinned copper, and isolated if needed to prevent contact with the mounting surface . Select wire gauge according to the current load and distance, aiming for minimal voltage drop (below 2.5% is recommended), .

Preparing the Wires

- Measure the wire length to allow a gentle bend radius and strain relief.
- Strip the insulation carefully without nicking the copper strands, which could reduce current capacity .
