

How to directly connect fiber optic cable to drop cable



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables are connected to drop cables using pre-terminated connectors, mechanical splices, or fusion splicing, depending on the installation scenario and equipment available.

Understanding Drop Cables

A fiber optic drop cable is the final segment of the optical distribution network, linking the distribution terminal (like a Fiber Access Terminal or Fiber Distribution Box) to the subscriber's premises and Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or Optical Network Unit (ONU) (Spring Optical), . Drop cables are typically low fiber count (1-4 fibers), flexible, and designed to handle tight bends without significant signal loss (Spring Optical), . They may be aerial, underground, or indoor/outdoor rated depending on deployment (FiberCheap), .

Connection Methods

1. Pre-Terminated Drop Cables

- Factory-terminated connectors (SC/APC, SC/UPC, LC) are installed on the drop cable before shipment (Spring Optical), .
- Plug-and-play installation: Technicians simply plug the drop cable into the distribution terminal or ONT without on-site splicing.
- Advantages: Reduces labor, ensures consistent insertion and return loss, and minimizes contamination or poor field termination issues.
